- 1. A huge earthquake struck off Kamchatka Peninsula at approximately 8:25 a.m. on Wednesday, July 30, 2025. In response, the Japan Meteorological Agency issued a tsunami advisory at 9:40 a.m. for coastal areas of the Seto Inland Sea and the southern part of Awaji Island in Hyogo Prefecture.
- 2. Tsunamis may strike repeatedly. Keep away from the coast and remain in a safe location until the tsunami warning is lifted.
