Revive Our Communities While Taking Infection Prevention Measures!

As the COVID-19 new case counts still remain high, it is important for us to continue to take basic infection prevention measures and get vaccinated.

Meanwhile, we also need to revitalize our communities through initiatives such as holding festivals and events. Let us gradually revive our communities by taking part in regional activities, while taking thorough infection prevention measures.

1. Thoroughly implement basic infection prevention measures and avoid risky behavior

- Thoroughly implement basic infection prevention measures, such as ventilating rooms regularly, wearing face masks properly, frequently washing or disinfecting your hands, keeping a safe distance from others, and avoiding the Three Cs (confined spaces, crowded places, and close contact).
- You may remove your face masks under the following conditions:
 - (1) Indoors: You can secure a proper distance and will not be having conversations
 - (2) Outdoors: You can secure a proper distance or will not be having conversations
- If you have symptoms, such as fever and cough, refrain from going out, and call and visit a medical institution.

2. Get vaccinated

- Vaccination is effective in preventing the onset and exacerbation of the disease. Those who have not been vaccinated are highly recommended to get vaccinated.
- Even if the infected person is young, there is a risk of exacerbation or prolonged symptoms and the possibility of infecting others. Therefore, we ask young people to get vaccinated as soon as possible.
- We also ask those eligible for a fourth dose (aged 60 or over, or aged under 60 and have underlying conditions) and those who have not yet received a third dose to get vaccinated as soon as possible.

3. Conduct activities in communities while taking proper measures

- You do not need to refrain from holding events as long as infection prevention measures are thoroughly implemented. Let us
 gradually revive our communities by taking part in regional activities, such as festivals and events, while taking proper
 measures.
- When using eating and drinking establishments, such as banquet halls, restaurants, and bars, be sure to wear face masks during conversations.
- Be sure to prepare for wind and flood disasters in the upcoming heavy rain season. Please check the hazard map of your area and your emergency supplies (face masks, portable disinfectant, etc.) once again.
